WATER TASTING CONTEST AND LIWC BOOTH INFORMATION

Please pass this on to whoever is manning the booth or picking up bottles.

1. Bottles are available for pick up. **TWO** bottles to a customer. If you are a daily winner you will be notified to pick up a second set of bottles to be returned the day before the finals.
2. Each bottle will be retagged upon receipt at PACE ANALYTICAL by H2M, with the letters A, B, C, D, and E. Only the PR committee will know which supplier is which letter. There will be different waters in the AM and PM on any given day.
3. We ask that you dress neatly (business casual attire or water district uniforms), speak clearly and be prepared to answer questions about the water business. Your job is to get the public to taste the water and vote. Booth participants can vote.
4. We are in the New Campus Center building just past the Administration Building (Horton Hall). Campus map attached.
5. **You MUST get a parking permit from campus police**. Stop at the police booth off of the main campus entrance road to pick up the permit. Parking without a permit will get you a ticket. Speeding over 30 mph will get you a ticket. Stop for pedestrians in cross walks. Park in areas designated on the permit or inquire from the police where you can park. Do not park in any spaces designated for the staff.
6. The display has to be set up each morning and knocked down at the end of the day. We will show you where it is located when you arrive. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled time so we can make a smooth transition.
7. The PR committee will be setting up everything daily at 8:45 AM. If you are participating and can be there by 8:45 AM to assist it would be much appreciated.
8. At the end of each shift (AM & PM) call Tim McGuire (516-427-1160) with results. Please double count the ballots before you dump the water if there is a tie get one more vote. Leave message, if necessary.
9. At the end of the day please dump remaining water and melted ice. Remember we are guests of the college so please keep the place clean and the floor dry. Smoking is not permitted in any college building.
10. LIWC is providing handouts and water bottles.

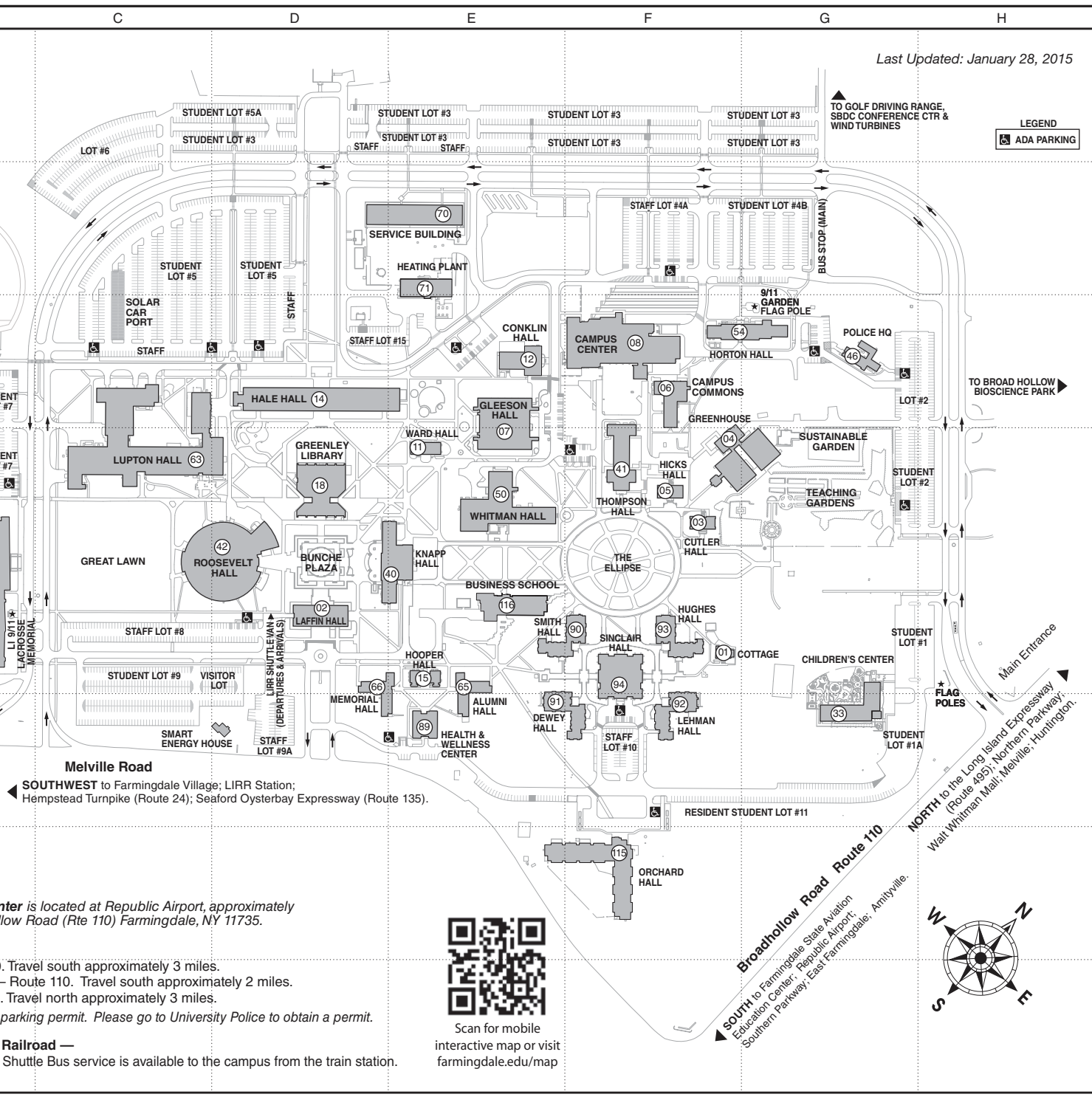
Directions to the campus via Automobile —

- Southern State Parkway: Exit 32N – Route 110. Travel north approximately 3 miles.

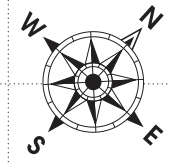
All vehicles parked on campus must have a valid parking permit. Please go to University Police to obtain a permit.
